

IMPORTANT DATES FOR 2024 TRYOUTS

- ▶ Oct. 18th Mandatory Parent Meeting in the Cafeteria at 7:00pm (Must have at least 1 parent attend!)
- Nov. 10th Physical form due date for Fall Conditioning
- Nov. 13th First day of Fall Conditioning (Monday & Wednesday 3:30-4:45pm, must have physical, meet in 214)
- ▶ Jan.9th Mandatory Final Tryout Meeting in room 218 at 3:40pm
- ► Jan. 12th All forms and physicals due to Coach DePlanche by 3:30pm if you plan to tryout!
- ▶ Jan. 13th Work day in the Stadium 9:00am-Noon
- ▶ Jan. 16th First day of Tryouts! 5:00-8:00pm in the stadium
- ▶ Jan. 19th Last day of tryouts, Teams named by 9:00pm

Teams

- ► We have 2 teams at KMHS, Varsity & JV
- JV team will consist of 19-21 9th 11th grade players (Seniors can not play)
- Varsity team will consist of 19-22 9th 12th grade players (Freshmen can play varsity!)
- Playing time is earned, not guaranteed.

Other General Information

- ► You must pass 3 out of 4 classes this semester and have the required number of credits after this semester.... 9th grade- 3, 10th grade 5, 11th grade 11, 12th grade- 17
- All steps of the new online Athletic Registration must be completed BEFORE you can do anything at all (including conditioning) If you complete it now, you will be good for tryouts as well.
- All physicals must be on the Cobb County physical form and must be signed and cleared by a Doctor (M.D., D.O., or Nurse Practitioner)
- If you come to conditioning you will need to have someone pick you up ON TIME every day! If they cannot be here on time, then do not come to conditioning that day.
- If you make a team, we practice Mon.-Fri. 3:45pm-5:45pm. You must have a ride home every day!

Player Expectations

- Attendance practice and games are mandatory; must communicate with coach if conflict arises as early as possible
- ▶ High School vs Club conflicts we expect you to put your high school team first during the Spring. We do value club soccer and understand the need to attend certain events, such as showcase tournaments, from time to time. We will deal with this on a case by case basis. Again, early communication is key.
- Fundraise to help pay for booster dues and the Hilton Head Trip (Varsity Only)

Class and Character Matter

- We have high expectations for our players.
 You represent the program at all times.
- ▶ Be a leader around KMHS; do not disrespect teachers, students, teammates etc. Do not behave in a manner in which you would receive ISS or OSS.

Parent Expectations

- Volunteering to help the booster club.
- Pay your dues in full by the kickoff night (Jan. 26, 2024). \$500 JV, \$600 Varsity. The tryout fee does go toward your dues
- Provide 1 pregame meal for your team.
- Work your concession stand duty.
- Pick up your son from training and after games on time.
- Come to the games and support your son and his team!
